Further reports on the Archbishop of Canterbury's 12-day visit to the Holy Land. The Guardian reports that Archbishop Justin, accompanied by the UK's Chief Rabbi, Ephraim Mirvis, visited the Yad Vashem Holocaust memorial centre in Israel. Earlier the two leaders prayed together at the Western Wall in Jerusalem. The Mail publishes an Associated Press report that Archbishop Justin led prayers at the Jordan River. The Huffington Post, (see comment, below, and News from the Archbishop of Canterbury) publishes reflections from Archbishop Justin on his meeting with Iraqi Christians in Jordan on the first day of his visit. The Guardian report includes a video first posted on Twitter of Archbishop Justin speaking at the Zaatari refugee camp in Jordan.
