The article quotes an interview given to [Premier Christian Radio](#) by the Dean of Bristol David Hoyle who said "Opposition to slavery is dead simple. Slavery is wicked and evil.

"Removing the biggest window in the cathedral would be hugely difficult for me. If I can find a

way of doing that, I would be perfectly prepared to have that conversation.”
