Report on ComRes research which found that one in six young people surveyed identified as practising Christians. Article states that this suggests that levels of active faith among young people is higher than indicated by previous research. Jimmy Dale, the Church of England's national youth evangelism officer, is quoted speaking about a "warmth and openness" to faith among teenagers.

The <u>study</u> commissioned by the Church of England and Hope Revolution also found that some young people cited visiting a church building as an important factor in bringing them to faith. The Bishop of Worcester, Dr John Inge, the lead bishop for cathedrals and church buildings, tells the Telegraph the findings show the "the power of church buildings".
