Reports on the remarks of the Bishop of Kensington, Graham Tomlin, and the Area Dean of Kensington, Mark O'Donoghue, following a meeting at Downing Street on Saturday between survivors of the Grenfell Tower block fire and the Prime Minister, Theresa May. Bishop Graham is reported by the Press Association news agency as saying residents affected by the fire were passionate and angry during a lengthy exchange. Sky News carries an interview which is widely reported with Mark O'Donoghue, who said Mrs May showed empathy as she talked with survivors. Bishop Graham and Rev Mark are pictured in Downing Street with the group, including victims, volunteers and community leaders. Several news organisations report that the Mayor of London Sadig Khan attended a service at St Clement's Church yesterday, close to the scene of the fire, which has acted as a support centre. The sermon given by Rev Robert Thompson is guoted in the Guardian

article. The BBC, Times and Mail also report that a six-year-old boy gave his pocket money to Bishop Graham to help those in need.
