Reports on reaction in the aftermath of the London Bridge and Borough Market terror attacks on Saturday night. LBC carries a report and audio of an interview with the Archbishop of Canterbury while Christian Today reports on Archbishop Justin's sermon at the Pentecost celebration yesterday at Holy Trinity Church, in Folkestone, Kent, broadcast live on BBC One. Christian Today quotes Archbishop Justin as telling the Folkestone service: "The strongest power in the world is the love of Jesus Christ. It is more powerful than the evil of terror or the profound wickedness of the terrorist."

Southwark Cathedral is next door to Borough Market and remained closed as police continued their investigations in the aftermath of the attack. (See [Southwark Cathedral](#) update and statement) In live coverage, The Guardian reported that the Bishop of Southwark, Christopher Chessun, spoke to reporters at the security cordon around the scene of the attack and said “It’s very important that all community networks mobilise so that people of goodwill stand together... this must not undermine the things we cherish most.” CNN carries an interview with the Dean of Southwark, Andrew Nunn and The Telegraph also reports on his appeal for prayers following the attacks. The acting Bishop of London, Pete Broadbent was interviewed on BBC London where he said Christians' response should be to pray and “seek the peace of our city” and insisted churches would remain open for prayer rather than closing because of security fears.
